INTRODUCTION

This Technical Service / Training Manual (Job Aid Part #3756480) for the Model 235, 15" Undercounter Icemaker, is a compilation of manuals from the Whirlpool Corporation. The information in this manual has been reprinted by Sub-Zero Freezer Company, Inc., with permission form the Whirlpool Corporation. It has been compiled to provide the most recent information on safety, design, installation, operation, features, troubleshooting, wiring diagrams, and repair procedures of the model 235. This information will enable the service technician to troubleshoot and diagnose malfunctions, perform necessary repairs, and return a model 235 unit to proper operational status.

This manual has been designed to be used in conjunction with Whirlpool's Undercounter Icemaker video, #4322584. The video is divided into sections that "generally" correspond to the sections in this manual.

The service technician should read the complete instructions contained in this training/service manual before initiating any repairs on a model 235 unit.

- Replace all panels before operating.
- Use two or more people to move and install the ice maker

The last entries on this page are details and notes about the warranties.

- Five Year SEALED SYSTEM warranty, **parts and labor.
- Sixth through Twelfth year LIMITED SEALED SYSTEM warranty, sealed system **parts only.

ONE & FIVE YEAR Non-Residential Warranty Summary (Example: Office, Boat, etc.)

- One Year TOTAL PRODUCT warranty, *parts and labor.
- Five year LIMITED SEALED SYSTEM warranty, sealed system **parts only.

ONE & FIVE YEAR Display / Model Home Warranty Summary (Display units sold three years after date of manufacture)

- One Year TOTAL PRODUCT warranty, *parts and labor.
- Five year LIMITED SEALED SYSTEM warranty, sealed system **parts only.

Warranty Details:


- * Total Product Parts includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - Electronic Control System Components, Switches, Fan Motor & Blade, Solenoid, Drain Tubes, Wiring, Water Valve, Door hinge, Circulating Pump Components, Thermistors, Cutter Grid, Compressor Electricals, etc. . .
- ** Sealed System Parts include the following: Compressor, Condenser, Evaporator/Heat Exchanger Assembly, Filter-Drier, Hot-Gas Valve, All Tubing That Carries the Freon.

NOTE: Condenser Fan Motor, Freon, Solder and compressor electricals are NOT considered sealed system parts.

Warranty Notes:


- All warranties begin at the time of the unit's initial installation.
